Public Interest Incorporated Foundation Kawasaki Institute of Industrial Promotion Outlines for Implementation etc. for Ethical Education in Research

(Purpose)

Article 1 The purpose of this outline is to raise credibility and justice of Public Interest Incorporated Foundation Kawasaki Institute of Industrial Promotion (the foundation). The outline shall determine implementation etc. in research and development which are defined in the article 4 of the foundation's articles of incorporation.

(Main items for Ethical Education in Research/Research Ethical education)

Article 2 Ethical Education in research shall include the following items:

- (1) The Code of conduct of the research scientists such as the basic responsibilities of the research scientists and attitudes towards research activities.
- (2) Etiquette to be observed with respect to research activities in accordance with the characteristics of the research fields
- (3) The other research ethics on compliance matters regarding research ethics

(Subject researchers)

Article 3 Subject to ethical education shall be research support staffs, the other institution, Corporations, and foreign students, relevant students (including graduates) who are engaged in joint-research, and the others those who are involved in research activities, other than research staffs.

(Research Ethics Education Officer)

Article 4 Director General of Innovation Center of NanoMedicine is nominated as a Research Ethics Education Officer.

(Implementation of research ethics training)

Article 5 Research ethics education officer must implement regularly research ethics training through various opportunities that were stipulated in Article 3.

(Installation of Mentors and their roles)

Article 6 Research ethical education officer may appoint mentors as a part of research ethical education so that especially young research scientists etc. can carry out research activities independently. Head of laboratory or Deputy Head of laboratory appoints mentor. Mentor must endeavour to have young research scientists etc. carry out independent research activities.

(Reporting)

Article 7 Research Ethical Education Officer has to report the implementation status of research ethics training to Chairperson.
