

**Open Innovation Basic Agreement (Basic Agreement on iCONM use)**

— Background —

The Innovation Center of NanoMedicine (hereinafter referred to as “iCONM”) was established by Kawasaki Institute of Industrial Promotion to promote the practical use of research and development of “nanomedical technology”. It is represented by the Center of Innovation (“COI”) program “Open Innovation Network for Smart Health” (referred to as “COINS”). Moreover, in promoting the formation of an international strategic zone in the field of Life Science by Kawasaki City, reflective of the “Tonomachi 3-chome area preceding land use area land use basic plan” iCONM has been developed as a leading facility that would become the core center of life sciences bases in King Skyfront.

A company that uses iCONM (hereinafter referred to as the “User”) commits to the following agreement for use.

Article 1 ( iCONM’s vision )

User shall aim to realize iCONM’s vision in cooperation with Kawasaki Institution of Industrial Promotion.

Article 2 ( Research contract etc. )

User shall conduct collaborative research with the Kawasaki Institution of Industrial Promotion for the purpose of Article 1, and shall set the title, expenses, period, etc. in individual contracts every time. However, when the User carries out research and development related to COI in COINS, It shall be implemented according to the research and development based on the "Agreement concerning the implementation of joint research and development" and the "cooperative research implementation agreement" which the Kawasaki Institution of Industrial Promotion and the User conclude.

Article 3 ( Compliance )

User shall comply with the individual contracts that the User conclude with the Kawasaki Institution of Industrial Promotion related to the operating guidelines, terms of use and other basic contracts which are defined by the iCONM Steering Committee.
